The lesson is made far more interesting when Gooney's uncle, Dr. Oglethorpe, brings a full-sized skeleton to classthough Gooney finds herself playing detective when the skeleton mysteriously disappears. An exuberant free spirit who loves dressing in outrageous outfits, Gooney Bird is just as happy playing teacher as she is telling wild stories to entertain her classmates, in Lowry's series of fast-paced, entertaining, sometimes poignant chapter books for readers 6 to 9.
